We have a counselor-in-training program that allows a select few 14 - 15 year old campers develop leadership skills, gain confidence, and have fun at the same time. Our campers are usually from seven through 14 years old and are grouped together for most activities. It is important to understand that the language of our camp is English. All of our campers are able to communicate to a certain degree in English. Campers often come to camp for one, two or three sessions. Our camper/staff ratio is about 3:1, reflecting our strong commitment to a safe and professional camp environment.
